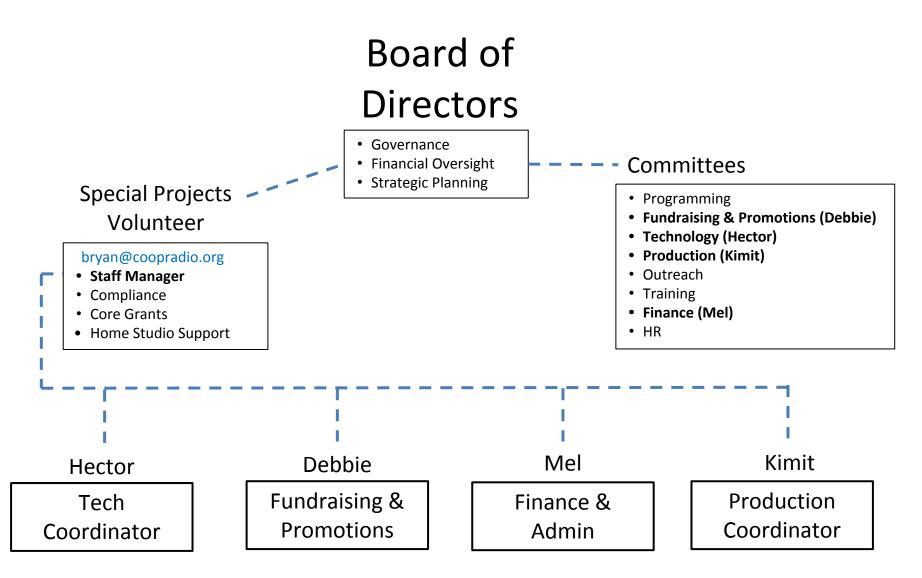

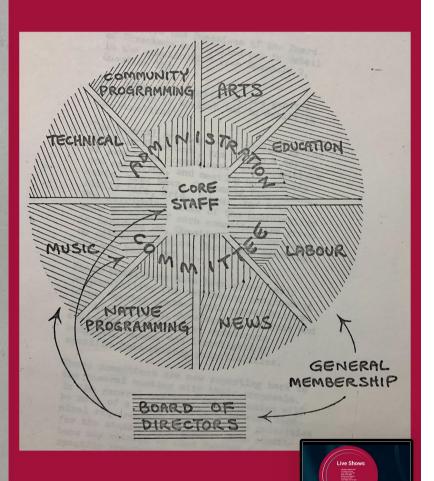
Board Report - 1975

report.



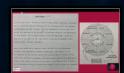
